By its long isolation from the outside world Myanmar has maintained its traditions, style and religion. With 1000 years of history and more than 100 ethnic groups living in this country just as big as France, don't expect to capture more than a glimpse in ten days. But this glimpse will surely be intense: Wander the vast temple field of Bagan, enjoy bustling floating markets beside Inle Lake and hike past monkeys up Mt Popa - the spiritual centre of the 37 Nat (spirits). Snorkel in the clear waters of Ngapali Beach, see a marionette show in Mandalay and walk around pagodas in the old capital Ava. Take in life along the river on a slow boat trip down the Ayeyarwady and admire Yangon's supposedly 2500-years-old golden Shwedagon Pagoda. And finally, meet the friendly and gentle people of Myanmar who call foreigners „guests“. Described by Rudyard Kipling as „quite unlike any land you know about“, **Myanmar simply is a Wonderland.**

Day 1: Shanghai - Mandalay

Flight Shanghai - Mandalay (via Kunming)

Immigration formalities

Meet & Greet in the Airport,
Transfer to your hotel

Your guided city tour in the afternoon helps you to get a first overview of the city itself and its numerous monasteries. Finally drive to Mandalay Hill for a spectacular sunset.. Spend the evening at the open market looking for gems (apple green Jade or Rubins!). Night at centrally located 4* Hotel, Mandalay



Day 3: Ayeyarwady River Cruise

Breakfast & Transfer to the Pier
Enjoy a slow trip on the mighty Ayeyarwady River from Mandalay to Bagan by Shwekeinnery Boat (departs 07:00, reaches Bagan about 15:30 - depending on water level). Lunch is provided on the boat.

After arriving in Bagan there is some time for a first exploration of the temple fields. Transfer to your hotel

Day 2: Ava - The Old Capital

Breakfast

Today you visit the former capital Ava which is located on an island that can be reached by local ferry, crossing the Myitnge River. Pass through the ancient city walls by horsecart and see the remains of the ancient city: the brick and stucco monastery „Maha Aungmye Bonzan“, the renovated Nanmyin Watch Tower and the impressive wooden monastery of Bagaya Kyaung.

After lunch, continue to Sagaing Hill. At U Bein's Bridge in Amarapura, built of teak from Ava Palace, another unforgettable sunset is awaiting you.

In the evening visit the Marionette Theater at Daw Ma Ma Naing- a MUST during your stay in Mandalay

Day 4: Templefields of Bagan

For early birds: Sunrise over the Templefields of Bagan
After breakfast start your excursion to the temple fields of Bagan:

The bell shaped Shwezigon Pagoda became a prototype for most other pagodas in Myanmar. Enjoy the colourful wall

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paintings inside Gubyaukgyi Temple and take a walk around finely decorated terrace shaped Htilominlo Temple.

Later – after a lunch break: Visit the Archaeological Museum, take your time for Ananda Temple - one of the largest and finest - and finally see the Buddhas of Manuha Pagoda. Pyattadagyi Temple or Shwesandaw Pagoda provide a panoramic sunset view of the city.

Experience local life by spending the evening at the local markets of Nyaung Oo.

Day 5: Nats at Mt. Popa

Breakfast

Start early to enjoy a cool day on the sacred Mt. Popa (4981 feet elevation). This mountain, standing alone about 35 km South-West of Bagan, is said to be the core of an extinct volcano. Also it is said to be the Center of the Nats - spirits that can either protect you or cause a lot of harm (be warned!).

Return to Bagan.

Day 6: Village Life at Inle Lake

Breakfast

Private transfer to the airport

Morning-Flight Bagan - Heho

Drive to Nyaung Shwe and hotel check-in.

In the afternoon enjoy some light trekking: From Maing Thauk walk 30 minutes to arrive at the Meditation Centre (Maing Thauk Monastery). After visiting an Orphanage school nearby, continue walking for 45 minutes to reach near Dalapin and return walk to Maing Thauk village.

Return back to hotel by boat.

Night at Paradise Inle Resort or similar



Day 7: Tour around Inle Lake

Breakfast

Excursion to Samkar at the South of Inle Lake. On the way, you can watch the unique technique of weaving



Lotus fibers and also stop by some local markets. Lunchbox is provided.

After visiting Phaung Daw Oo Pagoda, continue to the Western Shore of Inle Lake, where you find the beginning of a stair path leading to the hidden and unknown Inn Dein Pagoda complex. The Stupas are decorated with mythical birds and Devas.

Day 8: Shwedagon Pagoda in Yangon

Breakfast

Airport Transfer

Morning flight Heho – Yangon

Airport transfer to your Hotel

Embark on an afternoon of sightseeing in Yangon: Yangon

Jetty with the nearby world famous STRAND Hotel and the

old City Center of Yangon.

In the late afternoon, proceed to Shwedagon Pagoda and

enjoy the very special atmosphere here before and after sunset.

Walk the local markets close to the Pagoda after sunset ... enjoy the smells and sounds of Myanmar! Either you try some Burmese goodies here or you go to a Burmese restaurant

Payment:

Invoices payable prior to departure or latest 2 weeks after Invoice Date. China Trips payable to our accounts in China or Cash RMB. Credit Cards and Chinese Bank Cards welcome (conditions apply). International trips payable in US\$ or Euro to our accounts in Hongkong, Singapore or (by exception) in Germany. Cheques accepted (Euro/US\$ 30 surcharge applies).

Cancellation:

Cancellation fees apply, if you change or cancel the trip (or parts of the trip) after your verbal or written confirmation. We will attempt to reduce cancellation fees to a minimum and will calculate cancellation fees according to our actually incurred costs and time spent on your case. **In any case, a minimum of 10% of the total cost of the trip will be invoiced as Cancellation Fee.** Normally, cancellation fees will not be higher than 50% of the confirmed price. The closer a cancellation is to departure, the more expensive it gets.
